Important information from Northern Powergrid

Volunteering

At least 35% of your membership fee goes to mandatory affiliation fees for Archery GB, Northern Counties Archery Society (NCAS) and Yorkshire Archery Association (YAA). The remainder does not cover all the costs incurred with running the Club e.g. payment for the use of the field, the cost of the indoor facility and the maintenance and provision of equipment. We generate income to make up this shortfall by hosting major competitions and taster sessions amongst other activities and rely on members to volunteer some of their time to help with these activities. By becoming a member, you are agreeing that you will volunteer some of your time.
